General agreement

The University cooperation shall be encouraged in the following sectors:

- the exchange of students;
- the exchange of academic staff and researchers, in compliance with the relevant laws of the two Countries and with the internal regulations of both Parties, for a limited period of time, in order to implement joint projects in the field of education, in the sector of scientific and technological research and/or to take part in research projects already in progress at either University;

- the establishment of permanent contacts in the field of education and research;
- the joint establishment, development and promotion of innovative teaching activities;
- the exchange of bibliographical material concerning teaching and research activities and the exchange of multimedia materials;
- the participation in meetings and other academic events;

- the joint production of publications, academic journals and any other kind of publication of interest to both Parties;
- the elaboration of an appropriate system of acknowledgement of university credits;
- the exchange and diffusion of experiences in the field of university evaluation and assessment.

This is a general agreement, but we can sign the other particular agreements to do training in a course of study for the issue of

a **joint degree**, with the release of a single degree containing the logo of the partner universities and the signatures of its rectors

or **double degree**, with the release of more titles and, therefore, two different certificates by the two partner universities, each valid in the country that issued it.

Any other type of agreement
can also be stipulated
for a masters degree and
any other advanced course.
