Nursing

Nursing is a new First Cycle Degree programme of the Vanvitelli University, entirely provided in English, for the training of qualified health workers, according to the ESG 2015 (Standards and Guidelines in the European Higher Education Area). This course represents a unique programme in Italy; a global training opportunity for specialized personnel from different nationalities who will be able to benefit from the training capabilities of our highly qualified professors.

A new Course provided entirely in English

Since the programme is entirely taught in English, it is acknowledged by the NMC (Nursing and Midwifery Council) equivalent to passing the IELTS (International English Language Testing System) test recognized in all European Countries.



Course structure

The programme has a duration of 3 years. Candidates must pass an entry test usually held in the month of September. Professional skills are achieved through theoretical training based on lectures, seminars, work groups and practical training in hospitals and other public or private facilities of the National Health Service aimed at the acquisition of overall skills, which include knowledge, personal attitudes and practical applications necessary to practice the nursing profession. The student is gradually enriched with knowledge in increasingly complex disciplines for a complete approach with patients. Professors are available for students in any moment to facilitate their studies.

The cost of the course varies from € 16.00 to a maximum of € 2.710.00 per year according to the students' family or personal income.

Services

The International Relations Office of the Vanvitelli University and a Welcome Desk Service support students helping them fill out all the necessary paperwork to request the Study Visa, residence permit, register to the Local Health Service, in finding a suitable accommodation and providing all the necessary information when living in a foreign Country. These services will be available to students from their arrival to their graduation. Special services are provided for students with disabilities both in didactic and clinical structures. If necessary, a personal tutorial trainer is also available.

A wider student audience

Nursing is aimed at foreign students who choose our country as the location of their university studies, but also to Italian students who wish to obtain a qualification that opens doors to greater job opportunities.

A degree that can be spent in Italy and abroad

The language used for the Course is English but nursing graduates must also acquire an appropriate knowledge of the oral and written skills in Italian, both in the specific field of competence and for the exchange of general information. In fact, Italian is the fourth most studied language in the world; its knowledge is a crucial factor of internationalization.



Access to a wider job offer

This programme responds to the strong employment demand of Nurses in Europe, in the United Kingdom and in all other Countries. There is a strong employment demand in the European Community (4200 calls in 2016) of health workers (doctors and nurses), graduated in Italy.

Some employment agencies and national portals show a request for 396 nurses from Sweden, 83 from Germany, 170 from England, and 51 from Belgium.

The Job Placement Section of the Vanvitelli University organises twice a year meetings to promote employment opportunities.

Requirements

High school diploma or another qualification obtained abroad and recognized as equivalent. B1 minimum level of proficiency in English. Successfully passing of an entry test

Work one year after graduation

This degree programme has a particularly high employment rate: as many as 70% of graduates find employment in the first year of graduation.
